The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 614733.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You inform us you will release some of the submitted information. You claim the remaining information in report 16-089242 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. You also claim the remaining information in reports 16-039153 and 16-060155 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that you may withhold the remaining information in report 16-089242 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) and the remaining information in reports 16-039153 and 16-060155 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2). Lastly, you must withhold the dates of birth you have indicated in the information being released pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
