Re: Request for the current roster of employees in a stated format

Dear Ms. Martin:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 611613.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the dates of birth must be withheld from the requestor. Section 552.102(a) of the Government Code excepts from disclosure "information in a personnel file, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." Gov't Code § 552.102(a). The Texas Supreme Court held section 552.102(a) excepts from disclosure the dates of birth of state employees in the payroll database of the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. *Tex. Comptroller of Pub. Accounts v. Attorney Gen. of Tex.*, 354 S.W.3d 336 (Tex. 2010). We have considered your arguments and agree you must withhold the public employees' dates of birth under section 552.102(a) of the Government Code.
