Dear Ms. White:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 612562.

The Town of Flower Mound (the "town"), which you represent, received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You state the town will release some responsive information. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title or registration, or personal identification document issued by an agency of this state or another state or country is excepted from public release. *See* Gov't Code § 552.130(a). The submitted audio recordings contain motor vehicle record information that is subject to section 552.130. You state the town lacks the technical capability to redact the information subject to section 552.130 from the recordings. Nevertheless, because the town had the ability to copy the submitted audio recordings in order to submit the requested information for our review, we believe the town has the capacity to produce a copy of only the non-confidential portions of the recordings. Therefore, the town must withhold the audible motor vehicle record information in the submitted audio recordings under section 552.130 of the Government Code. However, it

may not withhold any of the remaining information on that ground. As you raise no further exceptions to disclosure for the remaining information, it must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
