Re: Request for a copy of all police reports involving a named individual in the last 4 years, including cases # 16-25517 and # 16-21158 regarding incidents on 06/06/16, 05/05/16, and 05/11/16 at a named establishment on a named street and at another named address (PD Control # 1800-16)

Dear Ms. Crawford:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 624078.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Next, you claim Exhibit C-2 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibits D-1 and D-2 may be withheld pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the information and have determined that you may withhold Exhibit C-2 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibits D-1 and D-2 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2). However, you must release the basic information from Exhibits C-2, D-1, and D-2 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
