Re: Request for various categories of information relating to a named apartment complex, at a named address and the named apartment; request includes: any and all records pertaining to the incident involving an assault that occurred at the named apartment on or around 05/26/16 – 05/28/16 at or around 2am; any and all records related to any complaints, accident/crash reports, police reports, and or investigation, or police records involving another named apartment at another named address in Plano from 2009 – 2016 and another named apartment at a named shopping mall from 2009-2016; etc.; Reference no. 77910

Dear Mr. Wyatt:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 627977.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the information marked as "552.108" may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the information marked as "552.108." We agree you must withhold the marked motor vehicle record information in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code. Also, you may withhold the social security number(s) under section 552.147 of the Government Code. Lastly, for any living persons' dates of birth contained in the submitted information, you must withhold them pursuant to

section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at \*3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
