Dear Rep. Stephenson:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 624187.

The Office of State Representative Phil Stephenson (the "representative's office") received a request for all records containing four specified terms received from or sent to a named individual on behalf of the Texas County and District Retirement System during a specified time period. Although you take no position as to whether the submitted information is excepted under the Act, you state release of the submitted information may implicate the privacy interests of the named individual. Accordingly, you state you notified the named individual of the request for information pursuant to section 552.304 of the Government Code. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (providing that interested party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). We have reviewed the submitted information.

As of the date of this letter, we have not received any comments from the named individual explaining why any portion of the submitted information should not be released to the requestor. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the submitted information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
