### Standard Possession Order

The below information applies, unless your order states something different. Please review your order carefully to exercise your parenting time visitation schedule.

**CP** – Custodial Parent is the parent that has the right to designate the primary residence of the child(ren) and receives child support.

**NCP** – Non-Custodial Parent is the parent that has the right to parenting time according to the visitation schedule in the court order and the obligation to pay child support.

**NEW**

#### For Orders after September 1, 2021

**0-50 miles** – For parents who live 50 miles or **less** from each other, weekend parenting time begins at the time the child is released from school and ends at the time school resumes. If school is not in session, parenting time begins Friday at 6 p.m. and ends on Sunday at 6 p.m.

**Weekends** – The NCP should have parenting time on the first, third and fifth weekends of the month.

**Weekdays** – The NCP should have parenting time on Thursday nights during the school year, beginning at the time the child is released from school and ending at the time the child's school resumes on Friday.

**51-100 miles** – For parents who live **between** 51 -100 miles from each other, weekend parenting time begins at 6 p.m. on the day school is released and ends at 6 p.m. on the day before school resumes. If school is not in session, parenting time begins Friday at 6 p.m. and ends on Sunday at 6 p.m.

**Weekends** – The NCP should have parenting time on the first, third and fifth weekends of the month.

**Weekdays** – The NCP should have parenting time on Thursday evenings during the school year beginning at 6 p.m. and ending at 8 p.m.

**101 or more miles** – For parents who live **more than** 100 miles from each other, weekend parenting time begins at 6 p.m. on the day school is released and ends at 6 p.m. on the day before school resumes. If school is not in session, parenting time begins Friday at 6 p.m. and ends on Sunday at 6 p.m.

**Weekends** – The NCP should have parenting time one weekend a month, if the NCP sends the CP written notice 14 days in advance.

#### For Orders before September 1, 2021

Pick up and drop off for most parenting times are at 6 p.m.

**0-100 miles** – For parents who live 100 miles or **less** from each other, weekend parenting time begins at 6 p.m. on the day school is

released and ends at 6 p.m. on the day before school resumes. If school is not in session, parenting time begins Friday at 6 p.m. and ends on Sunday at 6 p.m.

**Weekends** – The NCP should have parenting time on the first, third and fifth weekends of the month.

**Weekdays** – The NCP should have parenting time on Thursdays during the school year beginning at 6 p.m. and ending at 8 p.m.


**101 or more miles** - For parents who live **more than** 100 miles from each other, weekend parenting time begins at 6 p.m. on the day school is released and ends at 6 p.m. on the day before school resumes. If school is not in session, parenting time begins Friday at 6 p.m. and ends on Sunday at 6 p.m.


**Weekends** – The NCP should have parenting time one weekend a month, if the NCP sends the CP written notice 14 days in advance.


**Children not enrolled in school** (regardless of the date of the order) - If your child is not enrolled in school, when school is referenced, you would use the schedule for the local public school district your child would attend, based upon where your child lives.


**Weekend Parenting Time** is highlighted throughout the calendar for first, third and fifth weekends.

*\*\*Note that the fifth weekend is always followed by the next month's first weekend.*

 **April 1st Annual Notice, Summer Possession** - NCP must give written notice to the CP by April 1st if they want to specify an extended period(s) of summer possession.

 **April 15th Annual Notice, Summer Possession** - CP must give written notice to the NCP by April 15th, designating the weekend they wish to see the child during the NCP's extended summer possession unless it interferes with Father's Day.

 **Mother's Day** - If the mother is not in possession of the child(ren) on Mother's Day, she's entitled to pick up the child(ren) on Friday at 6:00 p.m., returning Sunday at 6:00 p.m. Reasonable flexibility is encouraged on Mother's Day weekend.

 **Father's Day** - If the father is not in possession of the child(ren) on Father's Day, he's entitled to pick up the child(ren) on Friday at 6:00 p.m., returning Sunday at 6:00 p.m. Reasonable flexibility is encouraged on Father's Day weekend.


**Child's Birthday** - The parent not in possession of the child on the child's birthday is entitled to pick up the child for two hours between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

**Weekday** – Weekly parenting time during the school year begins on Thursday evenings, depending on the order, from 6:00-8:00 p.m.

**Weekends** – The first, third, and fifth weekends are highlighted in the calendar.

**Spring Break** – Children spend spring break with the CP in odd-numbered years and with NCP in even-numbered years.

**Summer** - If the parents live within 100 miles of each other, the NCP is entitled to 30 days of possession during the summer months. If the parents live more than 100 miles apart, the NCP is entitled to 42 days of possession during the summer months. The CP will have some parenting time rights during these periods.  **Thanksgiving** – is divided by odd and even years. NCP will have odd-numbered years and CP will have even-numbered years.

 **Christmas Holidays**

**Christmas A** – begins when the child(ren) are dismissed from school until December 28 at noon. CP will have odd-numbered years and NCP will have even-numbered years.

**Christmas B** – begins on December 28 at noon until school resumes after Christmas break. CP will have even-numbered years and NCP will have odd-numbered years.
