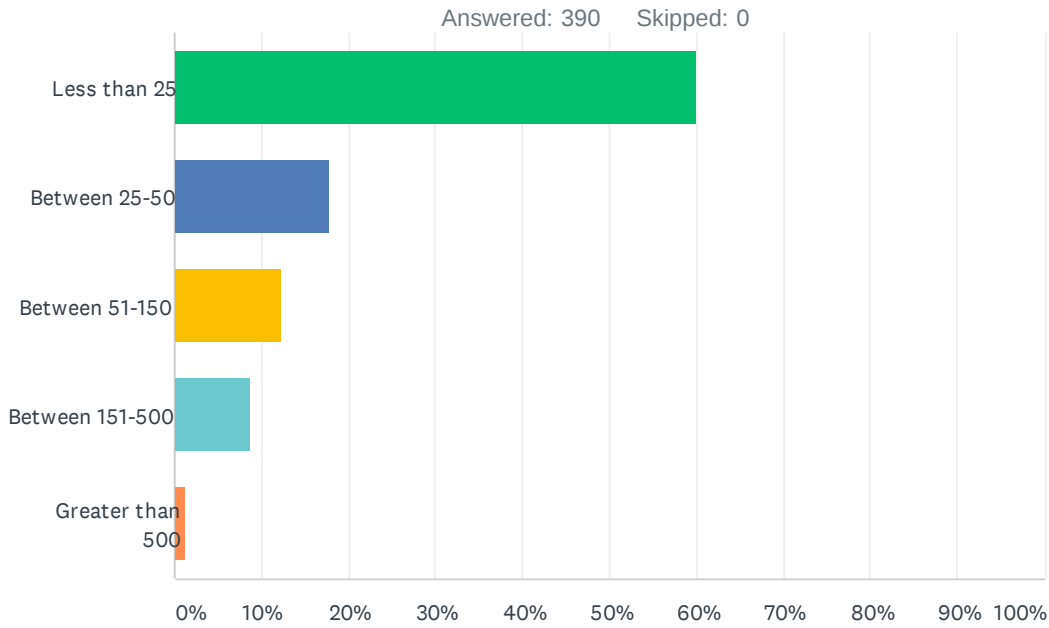

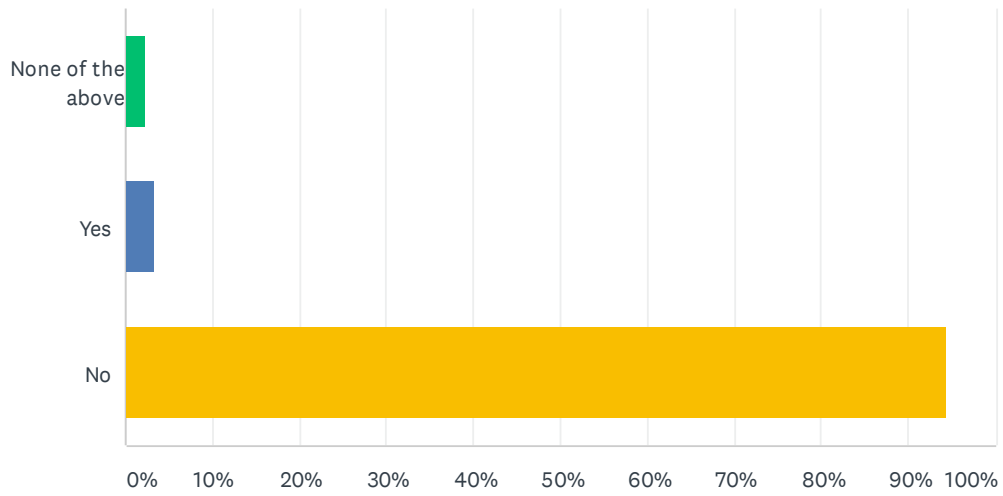
Q1 How many sworn personnel are employed in your department?

Q2 Does your department have a designated Cold Case Unit or Team with personnel assigned to work exclusively (full-time) on unsolved cases?

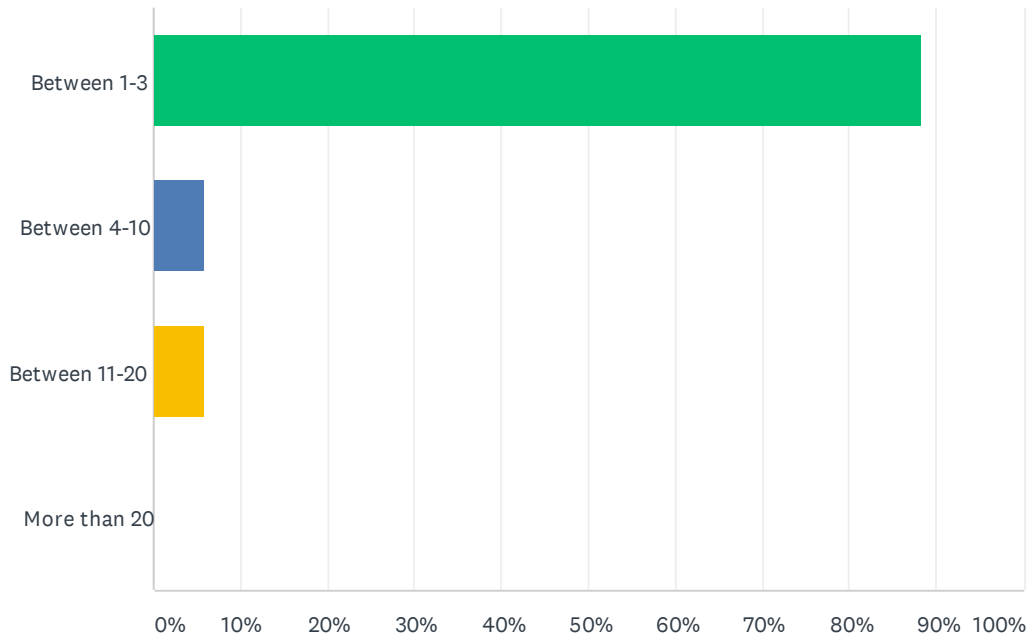

Q3 How many personnel are assigned to the Unit/Team?

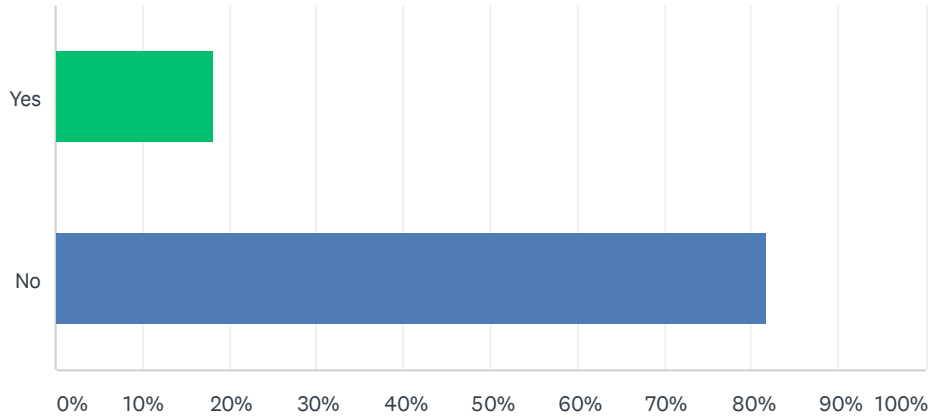

Q4 Does your department have personnel assigned on a part-time, as needed or volunteer basis to work on unsolved cases?

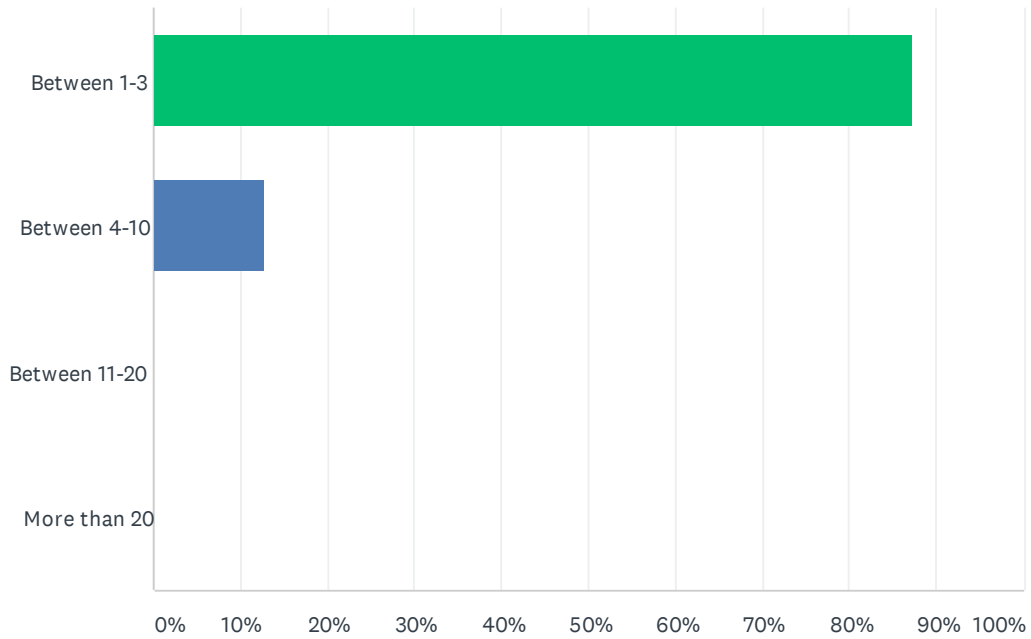

Q5 How many personnel are assigned to these cases?

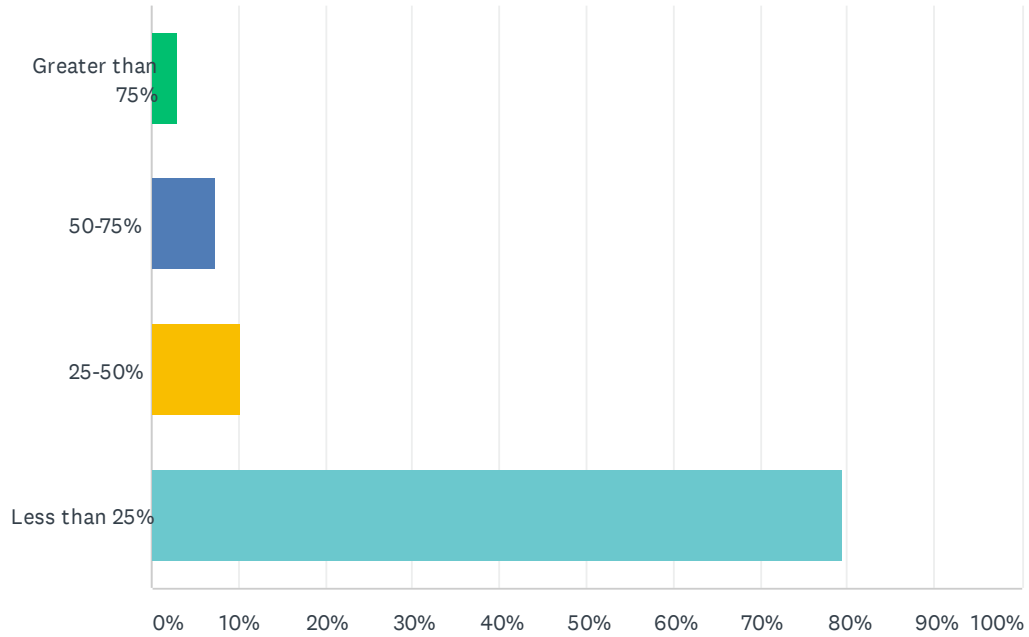

Q6 What percentage of the time is devoted to unsolved cases?

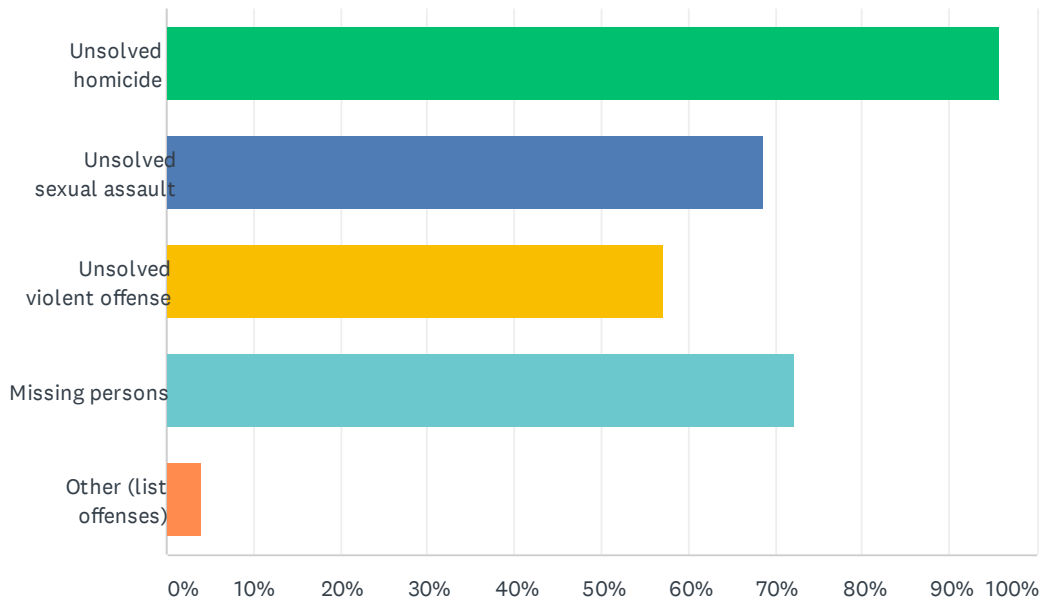

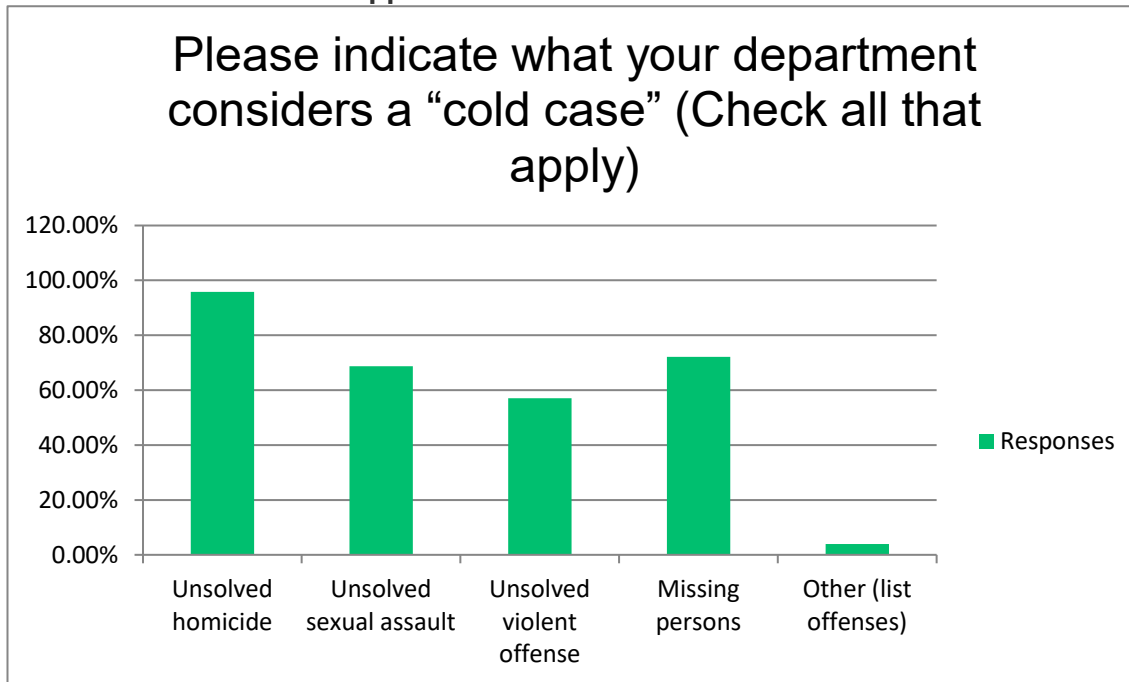

Q12 Has your department previously requested the assistance of another law enforcement agency on a cold case investigation?

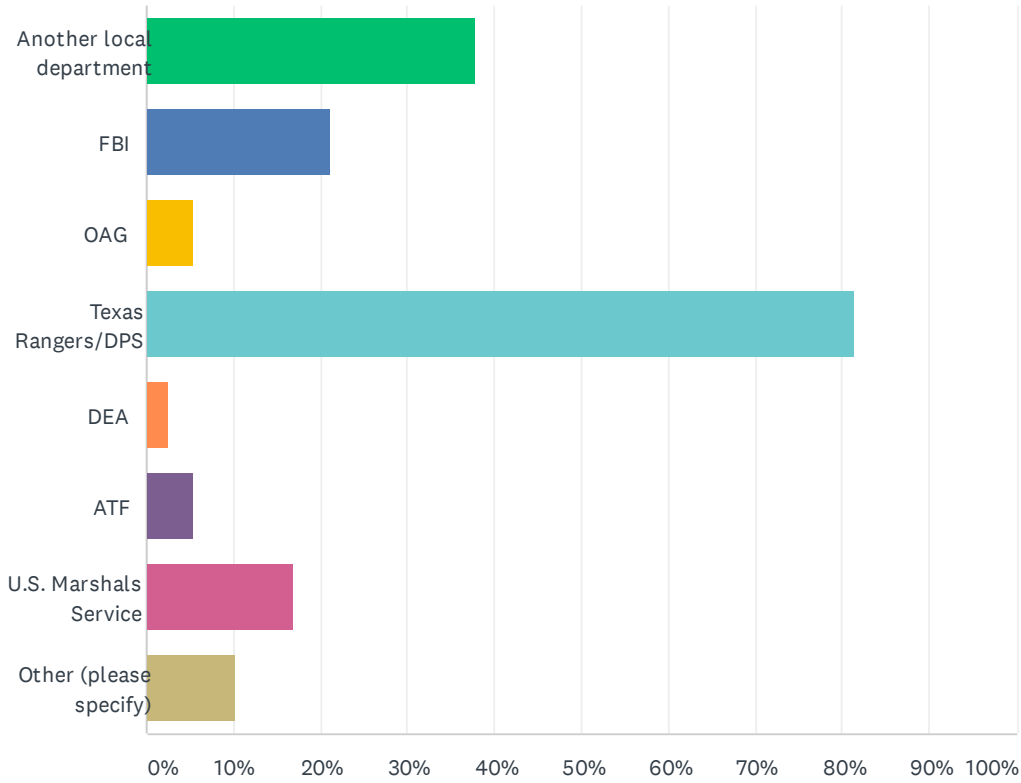

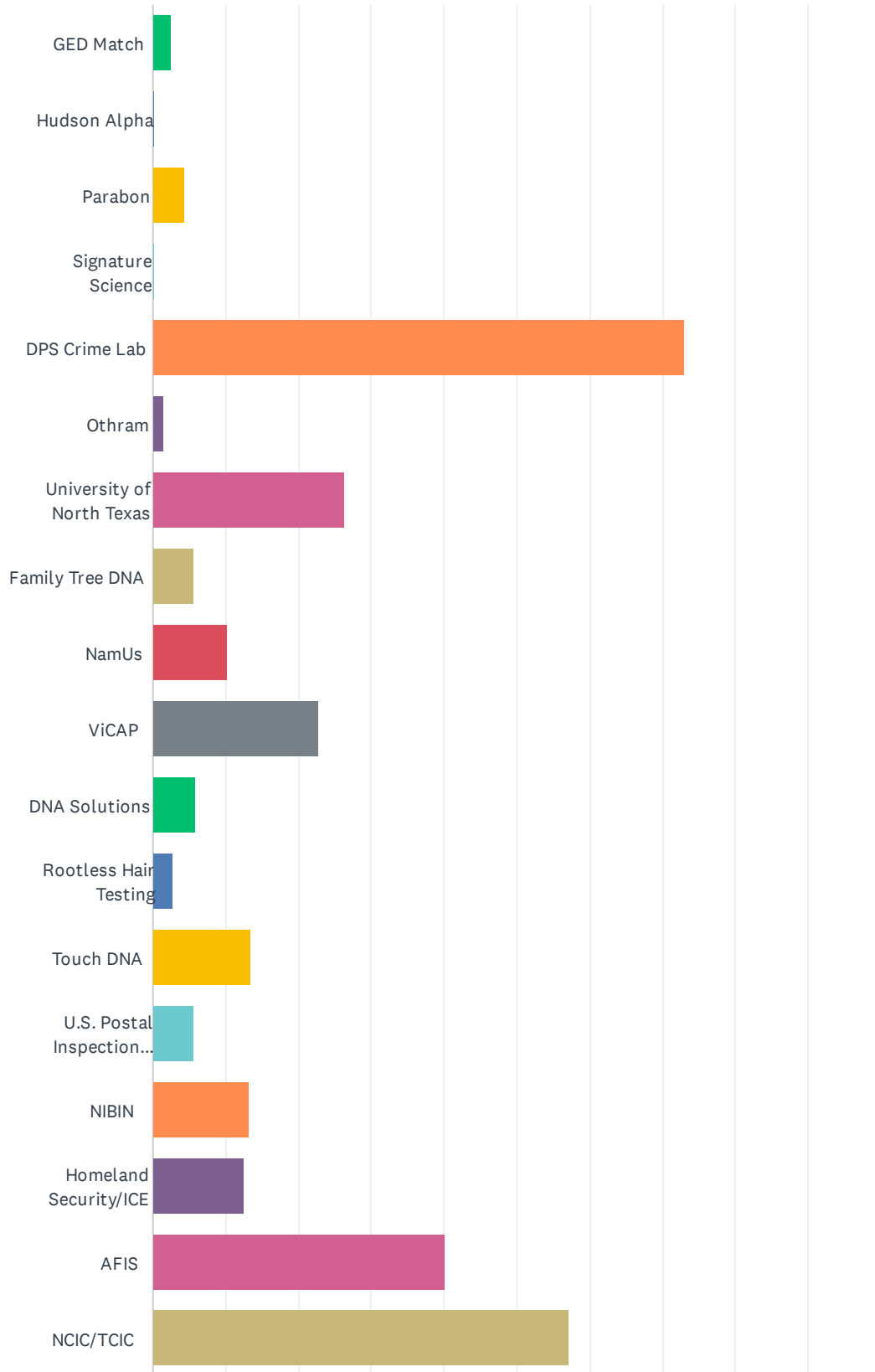
