

LAWS AND RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO SECURE AND PROTECT HOUSES OF WORSHIP

STATE -

Constitutional Right (TEX. CONST. art. I, § 23):

"Every citizen shall have the right to keep and bear arms in the lawful defense of himself or the State; but the Legislature shall have power, by law, to regulate the wearing of arms, with a view to prevent crime."

License to Carry a Handgun (TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 411.171-.209)

Requires the state to issue licenses to eligible persons to carry a handgun on premises not owned or controlled by the person

Trespass by License Holder (TEX. PENAL CODE §§ 30.06-.07)

Allows certain private property owners to exclude from their property persons licensed to carry a handgun upon providing effective notice

S.B. 535, 86th Leg., R.S., 2019 (codified at TEX. PENAL CODE § 46.035)

Clarified the law concerning the carrying of a handgun on the premises of a house of worship by a person licensed to carry a handgun

S.B. 2065, 85th Leg., R.S., 2017, § 11.001 (codified at TEX. OCC. CODE § 1702.333)

Exempts a person from registration or licensing requirements of the Private Security Program to provide volunteer security services on the premises of houses of worship
