Dear General Cornyn:

This is to request an opinion pursuant to Sec. 402.042, Texas Government Code, regarding whether the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services (PRS) may rescind a non-expiring waiver it granted to Ms. Lillie Beasley in 1990 that allowed her to continue to operate a child care facility. PRS rescinded that waiver and revoked Ms. Beasley's license on March 5, citing changes in the law regarding consideration of her single criminal conviction 30 years ago.

The statute to be interpreted is Section 42.072 (a), Human Resources Code, governing the revocation of a child care license. Enclosed is background information provided by Ms. Beasley.
