I am in receipt of your letter dated January 12, 2000 concerning my request for an opinion dated December 13, 1999. On November 29, 1999 I requested an opinion from the County Attorney on questions 1 through 6 of my Attorney General opinion request. The County Attorney responded by referencing his previous opinion to the County Treasurer as well as his request for an opinion from the Attorney General. Upon receipt of his letter, Commissioners Court, by majority vote, declared it's disagreement with his opinion and asked that I seek a separate opinion from the Attorney General. The Court felt that the questions asked by the County Attorney were not consistent with the questions the Court sought to answer.
