Dear General Cornyn:

Yesterday's announcement by the Farmers Group that it will leave the Texas market significantly worsens the homeowners insurance crisis facing the state of Texas. Combined with the refusal by some other companies to write new homeowners policies, Farmers' action creates a crisis of availability to match the crisis of affordability it has also engineered.

Farmers' behavior has far-reaching consequences for the people of Texas. It has placed families at risk of uninsured losses to their homesteads, stifled the sales of new and existing homes, and frustrated thousands in their dreams of home ownership. The effects of their reckless conduct will ripple through an already-struggling Texas economy.

I am requesting an Attorney General's Opinion on the following questions:

Does the conduct of Farmers Insurance in refusing to renew the policies of 700,000 homeowners in Texas violate state law?

Is Farmers Insurance an "authorized insurer" required to file a withdrawal plan under Article 21.49-2C of the Texas Insurance Code?

May the Commissioner of Insurance, pursuant to Article 21.49-2C(g) of the Texas Insurance Code, impose a moratorium on the approval of Farmers' withdrawal plan?

In light of the urgency of this situation, I request an expedited review and reply from your office. If you have any questions please do not besitate to contact me.
