Dear General Abbott,

I am respectfully requesting an attorney general's opinion on a matter concerning local option election petitions.

- 1.) In determining the minimum number of signatures required for a local option alcohol petition, should suspense list voters be included in the total percentage of registered voters required to sign the local option petition? Texas Alcohol Beverage Code 251.11; Texas Election Code 277.0024.
- 2.) Does an election official have discretion to create rules for calculating the minimum number of signatures required for a local option alcohol petition absent specific language in the Alcoholic Beverage Code? Texas Alcohol Beverage Code 251.31; Texas Election Code 277.0024; Attorney General Opinion No. JM-501.

I believe an opinion on this matter will help resolve confusion that exists on local option election petitions across the state. Thank you for your timely assistance on this matter.
