RE:

Whether a County Judge when temporarily suspended with pay in entitled to full salary. Whether a Constable and Deputy constable when temporarily suspended are entitled to car allowance.

Dear Sirs:

This is a request for an Attorney General Opinion as whether a County Judge who receives the State supplements for Misdemeanor Court is entitled to his full pay when temporarily suspended with pay by the State Judicial Commission. The question has been raised whether the State supplement payment for misdemeanor court should continue to be paid. The County Auditor asked the Judicial Commission and they suggested that a request for an Attorney General's Opinion be made.

In addition an inquiry has been made as to whether or not a car allowance should be paid when a Constable and his Deputies are temporarily suspended with pay by a District Judge under Section 87. of the Local Government Code.
