

Dear General Abbott,

I am requesting an opinion whether bicycles are exempted from municipal liability from injuries incurred by bicycles in facilities described by Civil Practices and Remedies Code Section 75.002(e). In particular, please note that Subsection (e) and (g) refer to specific activities. My staff has spoken with people from Midland who asked Speaker Craddick to carry the legislation to amend this section; according to staff, they indicated there was no intent to include bicycles in the liability exemptions granted by this section.
