Re: Authority and/or Duty to remove abandoned Mobile homes from County Road right-of-ways.

Dear General Abbott:

The question has been asked whether a Constable and/or a County Commissioner have a right or even a mandatory duty to remove an abandoned mobile home from a County Road right-of-way. It is the understanding of this office that two Mobile homes have been abandoned for several months and present a potential safety hazard unless moved.

Section 545.3051 of the Transportation Code provides that if a, "law enforcement agency determines that the property blocks the roadway or endangers public safety", that they may remove the property from a roadway or right-of-way.

The section further states that an authority or a law enforcement agency is not liable for:

- (1) any damage to personal property removed from a roadway or right-of-way under this section, unless the removal is carried out recklessly or in a grossly negligent manner; or
- (2) any damage resulting from the failure to exercise the authority granted by this section
