Re: Applicability of Texas Education Code §44.043, Right to Work, to school district consideration of a vendor's or a person's relationship with a charter school.

Dear General Paxton:

Issue and Legal Question

I am writing to seek your opinion regarding the applicability of Texas Education Code ("TEC") §44.043 to any action by a school district that would consider a vendor's relationship with an organization such as a charter school. I am also seeking your opinion regarding the applicability of Texas Education Code ("TEC") §44.043 to any action by a school district that would deny or diminish a person's right to contract or continue to contract with a school district because the person has a relationship with an organization such a charter school. I am concerned that some school districts in Texas may be requiring vendors to agree not to work with Texas charter schools as a requirement to either contract with or continue to contract with such school districts, or that school districts may be diminishing the ability of a vendor to work with a school district based a relationship with an organization such as a charter school. I would like your opinion on the following questions:

- 1. Does the term "consider" in TEC §44.043(b)(1) and the term "deny or diminish" in TEC §44.043(b)(2) mean that a school district cannot give any effect to a vendor or person's relationship with an organization in its procurement practices?
- 2. Does TEC §44.043 apply to all aspects of the procurement process from the beginning of the process to any subsequent contracts or agreements?

- 3. Does TEC §44.043 apply to all types of school district procurements, including those governed by TEC Chapter 44, Subchapter B, Texas Government Code (TGC) §2254.003, and TGC Chapter 2269.
- 4. Does TEC §44.043(b) apply to a business relationship between a person or vendor and an organization?
- 5. Does the reference in TEC §44.043(b) to "organizations" include charter schools?
