Presumptive Eligibility training offers a detailed review of how to assist a victim with completing and submitting a Crime Victims' Compensation application. Special emphasis will be placed on Eligibility Section procedures including: standard processing; Priority Processing; and Presumptive Eligibility. This workshop enables advocates and providers to access our presumptive eligibility process.
